A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing a new charter for the City of Commerce, approved April 4, 1991  
2 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4042), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 11, 1993  
3 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 3714), so as to change the compensation for members of the board of  
4 education; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 An Act providing a new charter for the City of Commerce, approved April 4, 1991  
8 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4042), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 11, 1993  
9 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 3714), is amended by striking subparagraph (H) of paragraph (40) of  
10 subsection (b) of Section 1.12 and inserting in lieu thereof a new subparagraph (H) to read  
11 as follows:

12 "(H) The superintendent of schools shall serve as the secretary and treasurer of the  
13 board. Members of the board shall, when approved by the board, receive a per diem  
14 of \$100.00 for each day of attendance at meetings of the board and while meeting and  
15 traveling within or outside the state as a member of a committee of the board on official  
16 business first authorized by a majority of the board, plus reimbursement for actual  
17 expenses necessarily incurred in connection therewith. The accounts for such service  
18 and expenses shall be submitted for approval to the school superintendent."

20 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2003.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
