- 10 WHEREAS, in recognition of his knowledge and experience, he served on the Board of
11 Directors of the Georgia Limousin Association, where his leadership was always valued, and
12 was an active member of the Georgia Cattlemen's Association and the Lincoln County Soil
13 and Water Conservation District Commission and their programs and efforts; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was a devoted member of Double Branches Baptist Church, where he was
15 a member of the Board of Trustees, the hospitality committee, and the choir, and his genuine
16 interest in the well-being of others and compassionate nature were admired; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was an avid horseman, who was skillful yet adventurous, and was always
18 accompanied by his very special Jack Russell Terrier named Sassy; and his many friends will
19 pay tribute to this wonderful man on the Terry Tankersley Trail Ride on March 24, 2002.

21 the members of this body express deep regret at the passing of Terrance Alton Tankersley
