A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring Leesa Woodall; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Leesa Woodall is a distinguished resident of Lamar County who has shown her
3 love for her community by her generous service in a variety of capacities; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she is the executive director of the Barnesville Ag Expo Authority; and
- 5 WHEREAS, since joining the authority in September, 2000, she has enhanced its
6 effectiveness and served its board of directors with her exceptional fundraising and
7 organizational skills and her unrivaled commitment to serving her community; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in recognition of her unique ability and willingness to serve, she was asked by
9 the officials of the City of Barnesville to establish and coordinate a Clean Community
10 Program, a project to which she voluntarily contributed for five years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she also established the City of Barnesville's recycling program; and
- 12 WHEREAS, as a parent volunteer for Lamar County Elementary School, she coordinated and
13 implemented outdoor classroom areas on campus, including a butterfly garden and an
14 arboretum of native trees of Georgia; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she is an actively participating member of the First United Methodist Church;

- 17 WHEREAS, she has also served on the Planning and Zoning Board of Lamar County, the
18 Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, the Solid Waste Committee, and is a member of
19 the Moonflower Garden Club; and

1 WHEREAS, in recognition of her extraordinary contributions she was honored as the
2 Barnesville Volunteer of the Year for 1989 and Outstanding Citizen of the Year in 1991; and

3 WHEREAS, a graduate of the Medical College of Georgia, she and her family have lived in
4 Lamar County for 18 years, to the community's great benefit.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
6 recognize Leesa Woodall as an outstanding citizen of the State of Georgia and honor her for
7 her exemplary service on behalf of her fellow citizens.
