A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia to recognize the substantial
- 2 gift from the estate of Deborah Green Jackson to Georgia Southwestern College in 1948 and
- 3 to affix an appropriate plaque at Jackson Hall on the campus of Georgia Southwestern State
- 4 University; and for other purposes.
- 5 WHEREAS, Deborah Green Jackson was an exemplary citizen and a most generous6 Georgian who was a daughter of Honorable and Mrs. William Green one of Lee County's
- 7 earliest families and prominent land owners; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she was born on April 29, 1854, married Phillip A. Jackson, and spent a lifetime
 9 of service to her community and to the First Baptist Church of Americus; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she died on January 20, 1948, and her will directed that the residual value of
- 11 her estate be given to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia to establish
- 12 a loan fund to assist students in financial need to attend Georgia Southwestern College; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the very generous gift of Deborah Green Jackson has benefited countless young
- 14 students, enabling them to pursue a quality education at this fine academic institution; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is estimated that this generous gift to the college has a current market value 16 of approximately \$4 million which clearly translates the substantial nature of the gift; and
- WHEREAS, the amended General Appropriations Act for State Fiscal Year 2001-2002 includes \$2.7 million to renovate Jackson Hall named for this generous lady and it is most fitting and appropriate that a plaque be affixed to Jackson Hall noting her life and bearing the noble message inscribed on her gravestone: "The history of this modest Christian may be
- 21 read in the grateful eyes of the thousands she has striven to help educate."

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that

2 the members of this body urge the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia to

3 recognize the substantial gift from the estate of Deborah Green Jackson to Georgia

4 Southwestern College in 1948 and to affix an appropriate plaque on the renovated Jackson

5 Hall bearing the history of the gift.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized

7 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Chairperson of the

8 Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, the President of Georgia

9 Southwestern State University, and the Chairperson of the Georgia Southwestern Foundation.
