- 2 WHEREAS, Thad Tuck, son of Terry and Jaye Tuck of Jonesboro, Georgia, will be awarded
3 the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished order conferred by the Boy Scouts of
4 America; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a candidate for this highest award in scouting must complete a rigorous program
6 of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only a rare proportion of the young men in scouting meet the supreme standards
8 of excellence demanded of candidates for the Eagle rank; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Thad is a junior at Jonesboro High School, is ranked in the top 10 percent of
10 his class academically, and plays varsity football; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Thad has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the
12 various special skills imparted through the Boy Scout program, passed his Eagle board of
13 review, and completed a challenging community service project; and
- 14 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Thad built three wood bridges on the hiking and
15 biking trails at Clayton County International Park; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting principles of honesty,
17 fairness, and service to community and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
18 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 19 WHEREAS, it is most fitting to recognize this outstanding young man for his achievements.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body commend Thad Tuck for his diligence, determination, and
3 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
4 congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
