A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the Atlanta Regional Military Affairs Council on its 50th anniversary; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Regional Military Affairs Council (ARMAC) was founded 50 years
4 ago as a program under the auspices of the Atlanta Chamber of Commerce and was moved
5 to the Cobb Chamber of Commerce in 1999, and

6 WHEREAS, the mission of the ARMAC is to educate and facilitate a smooth relationship
7 between the business and military communities; and

8 WHEREAS, every major military installation and military command in the metropolitan
9 Atlanta area has a representative on the council's executive committee, and the men and
10 women who serve on the ARMAC are justly proud of the council's 50 years of service; and

11 WHEREAS, the 50th annual Salute to the Military luncheon will be held at the Cobb Galleria
12 on April 29, 2002, at which those who serve our country in uniform, and those who have
13 done so in the past, will be honored; and

14 WHEREAS, it is only right and proper that this outstanding organization be honored for its
15 many years of service.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 honor and commend the Atlanta Regional Military Affairs Council for its 50 years of service.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
