A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Cedar Grove High School Marching Band; and for other purposes.

5 WHEREAS, the Marching Saints have performed for two professional football teams, the
6 Atlanta Falcons and the New Orleans Saints; have performed for universities in Georgia,
7 Alabama, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Florida; and have
8 received a superior rating for three consecutive years ; and

9 WHEREAS, the Cedar Grove High School Marching Band has earned the respect and
10 admiration of the citizens of Georgia through the band's performances for the children of
11 Coralwood School and at holiday parades for patients and staff of Georgia Regional Hospital
12 at Atlanta; and
