## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jartavious Johnson and Prince Lewis and inviting them to appear before the  
2 House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jartavious Johnson and Prince Lewis are brothers who are seven and ten years  
4 old, respectively, and students at the Pine Ridge Elementary School in Stone Mountain,  
5 Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, on Tuesday, March 19, 2002, as they were walking home from school, a man  
7 attempted to abduct Jartavious but was thwarted by the quick thinking and heroic action of  
8 his brother, Prince; and

9 WHEREAS, both boys were able to reach safety at a neighbor's house where they called the  
10 police; and

11 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that the clear-headed and courageous actions of  
12 Jartavious Johnson and Prince Lewis be appropriately recognized and commended.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
14 the members of this body commend Jartavious Johnson and Prince Lewis for their  
15 courageous actions and invite them to appear before the House of Representatives at a time  
16 to be determined by the Speaker.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
18 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Jartavious Johnson and Prince  
19 Lewis.
