1 Senators Stephens of the 51st, Price of the 56th and Johnson of the 1st offered the following
2 amendment:

3 Amend the Stokes, Thompson, Tanksley floor substitute to SB 467 by inserting on line 11
4 on page 1 immediately after the word and symbol "programs;" the following:

5 "to specify conduct which shall constitute a prohibited conflict of interest on the part of any
6 member or full-time employee of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles;"

7 By redesignating Sections 7 and 8 as Sections 8 and 9, respectively, and by inserting a new
8 Section 7 to read as follows:

"SECTION 7.

9 Said title is further amended by striking Code Section 42-9-15, relating to prohibited
10 conduct on the part of members and employees of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles,
11 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12 '42-9-15.

13 (a)(1) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this Code section, no member of
14 the board or full-time employee thereof, during his or her service upon or under the
15 board, shall engage in any other business or profession or hold any other public office
16 which business, profession, or office conflicts with his or her official duties as a member
17 of the board or as an employee thereof; nor shall he or she serve as a representative of any
18 political party or any executive committee or other governing body thereof, or as an
19 executive officer or employee of any political committee, organization, or association;
20 nor shall he or she be engaged on the behalf of any candidate for public office in the
21 solicitation of votes or otherwise become a candidate for public office, without resigning
22 from the board or from employment by the board.

23 (2) Without limiting the generality of paragraph (1) of this subsection, it is specifically
24 provided that no member of the board or full-time employee thereof, during his or her
25 service upon or under the board, shall accept any employment from or engage in any
26 course of business dealing with any corrections contractor. For this purpose, the term
27 "corrections contractor" shall include any person or business who or which is engaged in
28 the business of providing to any unit of federal, state, or local government any facilities,
29 materials, supplies, or services for use in the incarceration, supervision, or oversight of
30 criminal offenders.

1 (b) Except as provided by subsection (c) of this Code section, an employee of the board
2 shall not be required to resign from employment by the board if he or she becomes a
3 candidate for a public office of a county, school district, or municipality which does not
4 require full-time service or accepts appointment to such an office.

5 (c) An employee of the board shall be required to resign from employment by the board
6 if he or she becomes a candidate for the General Assembly or becomes a candidate for or
7 accepts appointment to a public office which requires full-time service."
