## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Cross Keys High School Indians boys basketball team; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the 70 different nationalities represented in the Cross Keys High School student  
4 body melded into one community of fans as their boys basketball team put together a sterling  
5 season that culminated in a Class AAA State Championship; and

6 WHEREAS, the Indians began the season by winning 15 games in a row and followed that  
7 streak by winning seven of their last ten games, and, as the season went on, basketball fever  
8 gained momentum among a student body with little tradition in the sport; and

9 WHEREAS, excitement grew to fevered pitch on the night of the championship game in  
10 Macon, when fans filled five "spirit buses" for the trip from Atlanta to witness their team's  
11 play against the proud Eagles of Mitchell-Baker High School; and

12 WHEREAS, the Eagles were looking for their fourth state championship in five years, but  
13 the Indians stood defiantly in their way; and

14 WHEREAS, the Indians fans in the stands were of many races and accents, but they cheered  
15 with one voice as their team built a lead, lost it, kept their composure, and played their hearts  
16 out in a magnificent game, and, when the final buzzer sounded with the score Cross Keys  
17 80 and Mitchell-Baker 78, Cross Keys had won its first state championship in any sport since  
18 students wore bell bottoms and tie-dyed shirts; and

19 WHEREAS, this remarkable team, led by Coach Bennie Gibbs, was made up of Kendall  
20 Ruffin, Michael Banks, Antonio Simpson, Lance Willis, Angelo Simpson, Oniah Mitchell,
