A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend an Act known as the "South Cobb Development Authority Act," approved April 12, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 3772), as amended, so as to change the provisions relating to the membership of the authority; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act known as the "South Cobb Development Authority Act," approved April 12, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 3772), as amended, is amended by striking subsection (a) of Section 3 of said Act and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) The authority shall be composed of seven members to be appointed and elected as provided in this subsection. One member of the authority shall be the chairperson of the Board of Commissioners of Cobb County or the designee of the chairperson. Three members of the authority shall be elected by the owners of the property which is located in the development area. Three members of the authority shall be elected by the owners of business establishments whose principal place of business is located within the development area. The initial three members of the authority elected by each group of such owners shall serve for terms of office of one, two, and three years, respectively. Thereafter, all terms of office of members of the authority shall be for three years, except for the chairperson of the Board of Commissioners of Cobb County."

SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
