AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend Code Section 35-5-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 security police for the Georgia Public Safety Training Center, so as to provide that such
3 security police shall have jurisdiction over property controlled by the training center as well
4 as property of the training center; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
5 for other purposes.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 35-5-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to security police
9 for the Georgia Public Safety Training Center, is amended by striking subsection (b) and
10 inserting in its place a new subsection to read as follows:

11 "(b) While in the performance of their duties on property of or controlled by the Georgia
12 Public Safety Training Center, such security police shall have the same law enforcement
13 powers, including the power of arrest, as a law enforcement officer of the local government
14 with police jurisdiction over such Georgia Public Safety Training Center."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
17 without such approval.

18 **SECTION 3.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
