1 Senator Burton of the 5th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend the substitute to SB 285 by inserting "to amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official

- Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to primaries and elections generally, so as to change the
 forms of identification authorized to identify electors at the polls;" after "title;" on line 1 on
 page 1.
- By redesignating Section 1 as Section 1A and inserting between "BE IT ENACTED BY THE
 GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:" and Section 1A the following:

"SECTION 1.

9 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to primaries and
10 elections generally, is amended by striking Code Section 21-2-417, relating to presentation
11 of identification to poll workers, and inserting in lieu thereof a new Code Section 21-2-417
12 to read as follows:

13 '21-2-417.

(a) Each elector shall present proper identification to a poll worker at or prior to
completion of a voter's certificate at any polling place and prior to such person's admission
to the enclosed space at such polling place. Proper identification shall consist of any one
of the following:

- 18 (1) A valid Georgia driver's license;
- (2) A valid identification card <u>containing a photograph of the elector and</u> issued by a
 branch, department, agency, or entity of the State of Georgia, any other state, or the
 United States authorized by law to issue personal identification;
- 22 (3) A valid United States passport;
- (4) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and
 issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government, this
 state, or any county, municipality, board, authority, or other entity of this state;
- (5) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and
 issued by any employer of the elector in the ordinary course of such employer's business;
 (6) A valid student identification card containing a photograph of the elector from any
 public or private college, university, or postgraduate technical or professional school
 located within the State of Georgia; or
- 31 (7) A valid Georgia license to carry a pistol or revolver;

1	(8) A valid pilot's license issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other
2	authorized agency of the United States;
3	(9)(7) A valid United States military identification card <u>containing a photograph of the</u>
4	<u>elector;</u>
5	(10) A certified copy of the elector's birth certificate;
6	(11) A valid social security card;
7	(12) Certified naturalization documentation; or
8	(13) A certified copy of court records showing adoption, name, or sex change.
9	(b) If an elector is unable to produce any of the items of identification listed in
10	subsection (a) of this Code section, he or she shall sign a statement under oath in a form
11	approved by the Secretary of State, separate and distinct from the elector's voter certificate,
12	swearing or affirming that he or she is the person identified on the elector's voter
13	certificate. Such person shall be allowed to vote without undue delay. Falsely swearing
14	or affirming such statement under oath shall be punishable as a felony, and the penalty

15 shall be distinctly set forth on the face of the statement."
