A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Randy Drew on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

3 ceremony on April 20, 2002; and

5 the Boy Scouts of America; and

15 himself but also to his family and troop.

17 the members of this body recognize and commend Randy Drew for his diligence and
18 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
