A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Cobb Family Resources and recognizing Cobb Family Resources Day at the
2 state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the week of April 1-5, 2002, has been designated as National Community
4 Development Week by the United States Congress and the United States Department of
5 Housing and Urban Development; and

6 WHEREAS, Cobb County is a participant in the Community Development Block Grant
7 Program, which is a vital and crucial resource used by Cobb Family Resources to address
8 pressing county-wide housing and community development needs; and

9 WHEREAS, Cobb Family Resources has performed exemplary work and service to and on
10 behalf of needy citizens in Cobb County; and

11 WHEREAS, in Cobb County and in communities throughout the nation, the Community
12 Development Block Grant Program has helped forge stronger working relationships among
13 local governments, nonprofit organizations, and neighborhood residents.
