A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Savannah Chapter No. 2 of the United Daughters of the Confederacy; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Civil War is among the most significant occurrences to have affected the
4 United States and the State of Georgia, having both historical importance and personal
5 significance to many Georgians; and

6 WHEREAS, the Savannah Chapter No. 2 was formed on September 11, 1894, just one day
7 after the organization of the United Daughters of the Confederacy in Nashville, Tennessee,
8 and the chapter has worked to honor the courage and sacrifice of the heroic men and women
9 of the Confederacy and to preserve those places made historic by their valor; and

10 WHEREAS, it is through the work of dedicated women such as these Daughters of the
11 Confederacy that the South retains a strong and vibrant sense of its wonderful history; and

12 WHEREAS, this chapter has always worked diligently to carry out the purposes of the
13 organization which include, among other things, to contribute in the areas of memorials,
14 education, history, patriotism, and benevolence; and

15 WHEREAS, on Sunday, April 28, 2002, the United Daughters of the Confederacy will meet
16 at Forsyth Park in Savannah at the Confederate monument to commemorate Confederate
17 Memorial Day, a day in which we honor the men who fought and died for the Confederate
18 States of America.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body wish to commend the Savannah Chapter No. 2 of the United
21 Daughters of the Confederacy for over 107 years of commitment to the memory of the heroes
22 of the War Between the States.
