

**ADOPTED**

1 The Senate Public Safety Committee offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 1368 by striking lines 1 through 4 of page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:

4 "To amend Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to motor vehicles  
5 and traffic, so as to change certain provisions relating to applications and fees for drivers'  
6 licenses; to change certain provisions relating to".

7 By inserting "to provide an effective date;" after "requirement;" on line 7 of page 1.

8 By striking lines 10 and 11 of page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to motor vehicles and traffic,  
10 is amended by striking subsection (c)".

11 By striking "article" on line 21 of page 1 and inserting "title" in lieu thereof.

12 By redesignating Section 3 as Section 5.

13 By striking "(2) Every" on line 7 of page 2 and inserting "(2) Except as otherwise provided  
14 by subsection (c) of this Code section, every Every" in lieu thereof.

15 By inserting between lines 30 and 31 of page 2 the following:

16 **"SECTION 3.**

17 Said title is further amended in Code Section 40-5-25, relating to applications and fees for  
18 drivers' licenses, by striking paragraph (2) of subsection (d) and inserting in lieu thereof the  
19 following:

20 '(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (2) or (3) of subsection (a) of this Code  
21 section, each applicant for the issuance, reissuance, or renewal of a Class C, M, A, or B  
22 driver's license under paragraph (2) or (3) of subsection (a) of this Code section shall  
23 accompany such application with a license fee of as established by the commissioner, not to  
24 exceed \$8.00, if such applicant executes an anatomical gift pursuant to Code Section 40-5-6.'

25 **SECTION 4.**

26 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
27 without such approval."
