A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Ashburn,"
2 approved April 13, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4075), so as to provide for the terms of office of
3 the mayor and councilpersons; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Ashburn," approved April 13,
7 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4075), is amended by striking Section 5.11 and inserting in lieu thereof
8 the following:

10 style="text-align:center">Regular elections; time for holding.

11 Beginning in 2002 and every four years thereafter on the Tuesday following the first Monday
12 in November, there shall be an election for the mayor and city council for Posts 1 and 2. In
13 2003 and every four years thereafter on the Tuesday following the first Monday in
14 November, there shall be an election for city council Posts 3, 4, and 5. The terms of office
15 shall begin at the organizational meeting as provided for in Section 2.18 of this charter."

16 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
