## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending William Matthew Johnson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Student-Teacher Achievement Recognition program is sponsored by the  
3 Professional Association of Georgia Educators (PAGE) Foundation, Inc. and annually salutes  
4 a top academic senior in each participating Georgia high school as the STAR student; and
- 5 WHEREAS, William Matthew Johnson is one of the two students who tied for the title as  
6 the 2002 STAR student at Chattooga High School in Summerville, Georgia, and he has  
7 designated Kenneth Smith, the band director, as his STAR teacher; and
- 8 WHEREAS, to obtain the STAR designation, a student must have the highest score on the  
9 Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) and be in the top ten percent of the class; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Matthew is a member of the BETA Club, was a post-secondary option student  
11 at Floyd College, is a tuba player in the marching band and the concert band, performs in  
12 school drama productions, and was in the Rome Little Theatre Productions for two years; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in addition to his outstanding academic record, Matthew is an active member  
14 of Perennial Spring Baptist Church, and his scholastic achievements and community  
15 involvement reflect great credit on his school, his dedicated teachers, and his family.
