

ADOPTED SENATE

1 Senator Haines of the 46th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend the SCS to HB 1062 by inserting "to amend Code Section 17-3-2.1 of the Official
3 Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to prosecution of certain offenses, so as to extend the
4 time from which the applicable period within which a prosecution must be commenced
5 begins to run;" after "exceptions;" on line 6 of page 1.

6 By inserting between lines 20 and 21 of page 2 the following:

7 **"SECTION 2A.**

8 Code Section 17-3-2.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to prosecution of
9 certain offenses, is amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting the following:

10 '(a) If the victim of a violation of:

11 (1) Code Section 16-5-70, relating to cruelty to children;

12 (2) Code Section 16-6-1, relating to rape;

13 (3) Code Section 16-6-2, relating to sodomy and aggravated sodomy;

14 (4) Code Section 16-6-3, relating to statutory rape;

15 (5) Code Section 16-6-4, relating to child molestation and aggravated child molestation;

16 (6) Code Section 16-6-5, relating to enticing a child for indecent purposes; or

17 (7) Code Section 16-6-22, relating to incest,

18 is under 16 years of age on the date of the violation, the applicable period within which a
19 prosecution must be commenced under Code Section 17-3-1 or other applicable statute
20 shall not begin to run until the victim has reached the age of ~~16~~ 30 or the violation is
21 reported to a law enforcement agency, prosecuting attorney, or other governmental agency,
22 whichever occurs earlier. Such law enforcement agency or other governmental agency shall
23 promptly report such allegation to the appropriate prosecuting attorney."
