A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the 4-H Clubs of Georgia and recognizing the observance of 4-H Day at the
2 state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, 4-H provides a unique educational opportunity for students from nine to 19
4 years of age to learn valuable lessons outside the classroom and offers some 55 areas in
5 which students can compete with one another for college scholarships; and

6 WHEREAS, Georgia's 4-H programs are coordinated by the Cooperative Extension Service
7 of the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, and this
8 service is the major university outreach program focusing on the youth of this state; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Roger C. (Bo) Ryles of the Cooperative Extension Service has worked
10 diligently with the 4-H Clubs throughout Georgia during his tenure as State 4-H Club leader;

12 WHEREAS, the 2000 Georgia delegates to the National 4-H Conference, the 2000-2001
13 District 4-H Presidents, the 2000-2001 State 4-H President, the National 4-H Winners, the
14 Dean's Project Award Winners, and the winners at the 2000 State 4-H Congress
15 distinguished themselves through their personal accomplishments and deserve special
16 attention and praise; and

17 WHEREAS, these young men and women are outstanding representatives of the dynamic
18 resource this state has in its young people.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 recognize and commend the 2000 Georgia delegates to the National 4-H Conference, the
21 2000-2001 District 4-H Presidents, the 2000-2001 State 4-H President, the National 4-H
22 Winners, the Dean's Project Award Winners, and the winners at the 2000 State 4-H Congress
23 and express to them their best wishes in their future endeavors.

2 as 4-H Day at the state capitol.
