A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Dr. Robert Grady Cash; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on March 27, 2002, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the untimely passing of Dr. Robert Grady Cash; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born in Valdese, North Carolina, but had lived in Savannah since 1979;
5 practiced dentistry and orthodontics in Savannah, Wilmington Island, and Rincon, Georgia;
6 was affiliated with Candler Hospital and memorial Health University Medical Center; and
7 published many dental and orthodontic articles in a number of professional journals; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 1974, he received his doctor of dentistry from Emory University; in 1988,
9 he was ranked number one at the Emory University Department of Orthodontics; and in
10 1999, he was appointed a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Georgia Dental Association, the American Dental
12 Association, the Emory University Alumni Board, and had served on the advisory board of
13 Armstrong University School of Dental Hygiene; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he had served as president of the Savannah Dental Society in 1990, as president
15 of the Southeastern District Dental Society from 1993 to 1994, and as president of the
16 Georgia Association of Orthodontists from 1994 to 1995; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was an Eagle Scout, had received the God and Country Award, and served
18 on the Executive Board of the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he was the recipient of many awards including the Special Award of
20 Appreciation from the Savannah Dental Society, the Georgia Dental Association Honorable
21 Fellow Award, and the Pierre Fuchard Academy Honor Society; and

1 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Wilmington Island Presbyterian Church and served on
2 the Board of Deacons, a member of the Civitan Club of Savannah, the United Way Beacon
3 Club, the Savannah Quarterback Club, the Marsh Hunting preserve, the Millhaven Plantation
4 Dove Club, the Savannah Yacht Club, and the Wilmington Island Club; and

5 WHEREAS, he consistently demonstrated a solid commitment to his profession and to his
6 community and his untimely passing leaves a void in the hearts and lives of his wife, Sheila,
7 his sister Laura, and the many colleagues and friends who knew him.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
9 the members of this body express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Dr.
10 Robert Grady Cash and extend to his family their utmost appreciation for his dedicated
11 service to the citizens of Georgia.
