## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing condolences on the passing of Dr. Robert Grady Cash; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Dr. Robert Grady Cash, born in Valdese, North Carolina, earned a Bachelor of  
3 Science degree from Clemson University in 1974, and earned a Doctor of Dentistry from  
4 Emory University in 1978; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he developed a successful practice in dentistry and orthodontics in Savannah,  
6 Georgia, beginning in 1979; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was ranked number one at the Emory University Department of Orthodontics  
8 in 1988, and was appointed Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics in 1999; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he published many groundbreaking articles in the *Journal of Clinical*  
10 *Orthodontics*, *Journal of Pedodontics*, and *American Journal of Orthodontics, Dentofacial,*  
11 *and Orthopedics*; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he provided exemplary leadership within his profession, serving ably in the  
13 Savannah Dental Society as president, vice president, and secretary-treasurer; in the  
14 Southeastern District Dental Society as president, vice president, secretary-treasurer,  
15 legislative chairman, and member of the executive committee; and in the Georgia  
16 Association of Orthodontists as president, vice president, and secretary-treasurer; and
- 17 WHEREAS, his energetic and enthusiastic services earned many honors, including the  
18 Special Award of Appreciation from the Savannah Dental Society, Georgia Dental  
19 Association Honorable Fellow award, Pierre Fuchard Academy Honor Society, and the  
20 Georgia Dental Association Crystal Peach Award for Exceptional GADPAC service; and
- 21 WHEREAS, he was an active member of the Wilmington Island Presbyterian Church,  
22 serving as member of the Board of Deacons; and

1 WHEREAS, his cheerful manner will be sorely missed by both young and adult patients.
