2 WHEREAS, Max Lockwood has served as president and chief executive officer of the U.S.
3 441 Economic Development Council based in Douglas, Georgia; and

5 Douglas since 1979 where he has served as Mayor; and

6 WHEREAS, he has served at various times as a member of the Board of Directors of the

8 member of the Executive Committee for Georgians for Better Transportation, member of the
9 Board of Directors for the Georgia Regional Development Center, chairman of the Georgia

12 for the South Georgia Chamber of Commerce, and president of the Douglas Rotary Club; and

13 WHEREAS, he has received the State Bar of Georgia Liberty Bell Award, has been featured
14 on the cover of *Georgia Trend* magazine in recognition of his support of transportation and
15 was listed as a member of *Georgia Trend's* 100 most outstanding Georgians, and received
16 the Liston Elkins Award in 2000; and

17 WHEREAS, he is a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps and was a prisoner of war during
18 World War II.
