1 In memory of Hudson Lewis Bell, Sr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Hudson Lewis Bell, Sr., was a distinguished Georgian who was highly  
3 respected for his many contributions to his family and friends, his fellow citizens, his  
4 country, and the local community of Appling County, Georgia, who treasured this  
5 gentlemen; and

6 WHEREAS, this Surry, Virginia, native spent the last 32 years in Appling County with the  
7 support and love of his cherished wife, Marie Wyatt Haynes Bell, and his two children,  
8 Barbara Renee Bell and Hudson L. Bell, Jr.; and

9 WHEREAS, this valiant and heroic American was a pillar of service, which began with the  
10 United States Army during the Korean Conflict, where he served with honor; and

11 WHEREAS, the patriotic American extended his service to his community and state by  
12 founding Bells DUI-Drug Risk schools in 1991 to educate drivers and to combat the  
13 escalating problem of drunk drivers on Georgia's roads; and

14 WHEREAS, in continuation of his commitment to prevent drunk driving, Hudson Bell, Sr.,  
15 served as G.A.R.D.E. president for the State of Georgia for DUI and defensive driving  
16 schools for two terms.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body honor the memory and contributions of Hudson Lewis Bell, Sr.,  
19 and convey their sincerest sympathy to the members of his family.
