#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Andy Hendrix; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Andy Hendrix of Boy Scout Troop 350 has been awarded the rank of Eagle  
3 Scout, the highest recognition conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the Eagle Scout rank must complete a rigorous program of  
5 training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques; and
- 6 WHEREAS, few boys reach this lofty level of achievement and Andy has ably demonstrated  
7 the various special skills taught through the Boy Scout program and has completed a  
8 substantial community service project constructing two park benches and planting a rock  
9 garden at the Youth House of his church, Mars Hill Presbyterian in Acworth, Georgia; and

11 principles of honesty, fairness, and community service; and he has consistently conducted  
12 himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

14 accomplishments of this very dedicated Boy Scout from Kennesaw, Georgia, whose Eagle  
15 Scout Court of Honor will be on April 21, 2002, at Red Top Mountain State Park.

17 commend Andy Hendrix for his diligence in pursuing the highest award in the Boy Scouts  
18 of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
