## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Walter Boyt; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Walter Boyt has long been recognized by the citizens of Yatesville and this  
3 state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to  
4 the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,  
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced  
7 dramatically by his service as mayor of the Town of Yatesville for 31 years during which  
8 time Yatesville constructed sidewalks, a new water system, and a new public library;

19 Walter Boyt for his outstanding commitment and contributions to his community and this  
20 state and extends its best wishes for his future success.
