- 6 abuse; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 5 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to programs and
- protection for children and youth, is amended by striking paragraph (2) of subsection (c) of
- 12 Code Section 49-5-41, relating to persons and agencies permitted access to records, and
- inserting in its place the following:
- 14 "(2) Reserved A licensed child-placing agency, a licensed child-caring institution of this
- state which is assisting the Department of Human Resources by locating or providing
- 16 <u>foster or adoptive homes for children in the custody of the department, or an investigator</u>
- 17 <u>appointed by a court of competent jurisdiction of this state to investigate a pending</u>
- 18 <u>petition for adoption;"</u>
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 21 without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
