A RESOLUTION

1 Commending George W. "Jack" Strickland, Jr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, George W. "Jack" Strickland, Jr. is a native of Evans County where he is well
3 known and highly respected as a prominent businessman and an influential civic leader who
4 has contributed substantially to improve the quality of life of his fellow citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, he was born on March 1, 1925 and served his country with honor during World
6 War II; in May of 1948, purchased the Evans Concrete Products Company in Daisy, Georgia;

13 Hospital addition named the Jack Strickland Rehabilitation Center in his honor and his stellar

15 as well as the Chamber of Commerce and the Evans County Wildlife Club is highly valued.
