Code Section 42-9-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to prohibited conduct by members and employees of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles, is amended by inserting after subsection (a) a new subsection (a.1) to read as follows:

'(a.1) Without limiting the generality of subsection (a) of this Code section, it is specifically provided that no member of the board or full-time employee thereof, during his or her service upon or under the board, shall accept any employment from or engage in any course of business dealing with any corrections contractor. For this purpose, the term "corrections contractor" shall include any person or business who or which is engaged in the business of providing to any unit of federal, state, or local government any facilities, materials, supplies, or services for use in the incarceration, supervision, or oversight of criminal offenders."
