

**ADOPTED SENATE**

1 Senator Jackson of the 50th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 1406 by inserting on line 2 of page 1, following the word and symbol "fees;", the  
3 following:

4 "to provide that the department shall have the power and duty to promulgate rules and  
5 regulations governing the operation of land disposal sites for septic tank wastes that receive  
6 such waste from more than one business; to provide that no such facility not in operation  
7 on January 1, 2002, shall operate after July 1, 2002, unless permitted by such department;"

8 By inserting on line 8 of page 1, following the word and symbol "foregoing;", the following:

9 "to amend Chapter 2 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
10 Department of Human Resources, so as to provide that the department shall have the power  
11 and duty to promulgate rules and regulations governing the operation of land disposal sites  
12 for septic tank wastes that receive such waste from one business; to provide that no such  
13 facility which was not in operation on January 1, 2002, shall operate after July 1, 2002,  
14 unless permitted by such department;"

15 By inserting following line 5 of page 2 the following:

**"SECTION 1A.**

17 Said chapter is further amended by inserting following Code Section 12-8-40 a new Code  
18 section to read as follows:

19 '12-8-41.

20 The department shall provide by rule or regulation for the regulation and permitting of any  
21 land disposal site that receives septic tank waste from more than one septic tank pumping  
22 and hauling business; provided, however, that no such permit shall be issued except on the  
23 written approval of the governing authority of each county in which such site is wholly or  
24 partially located. No such site which was not in operation on January 1, 2002, shall receive  
25 septic tank waste on or after July 1, 2002, unless a permit has been issued by the  
26 department."

27 By inserting following line 8 of page 16 the following:

**"SECTION 6A.**

1 Chapter 2 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department  
2 of Human Resources, is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:

3 '31-2-8.

4 The department shall provide by rule or regulation for the regulation and permitting of any  
5 land disposal site that receives septic tank waste from only one septic tank pumping and  
6 hauling business; provided, however, that no such permit shall be issued except on the  
7 written approval of the governing authority of each county in which such site is wholly or  
8 partially located. No such site which was not in operation on January 1, 2002, shall receive  
9 septic tank waste on or after July 1, 2002, unless a permit has been issued by the  
10 department."
