A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending and congratulating Bernese Cagle; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Bernese Cagle has been recognized as the 2002 Woman of the Year in Service
3 to Georgia Agriculture; and
- 4 WHEREAS, it is an honor bestowed annually by Georgia Farm Family Health and Safety,
5 Inc., a nonprofit organization that promotes health and safety on Georgia farms; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the award is presented to the woman who is deemed to have made the most
7 significant contributions to agriculture in this state during the past year and gives
8 well-deserved attention to the tremendous contributions of women in general in the field of
9 agriculture; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Cagle is the co-owner of Cagle's Dairy in Hickory Flat which she operates
11 with her husband, Albert Cagle, and their children; and
- 12 WHEREAS, she was chosen to receive the Woman of the Year award because of her
13 innovative ways of presenting agriculture to the general public; and
- 14 WHEREAS, under the watchful eye of Mrs. Cagle, Cagle's Dairy offers numerous
15 opportunities for people to learn about the dairy industry and offers farm and dairy tours to
16 schools, families, and farm safety programs; and
- 17 WHEREAS, she was nominated to receive the award by Georgia Department of Agriculture
18 Commissioner Tommy Irvin who hailed her as a lady of stature in the agriculture community
19 and the standard for urban agriculture.

21 the members of this body congratulate Bernese Cagle, the 2002 Woman of the Year in
