A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and expressing appreciation to Terry A. McKenzie on the occasion of his
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Terry A. McKenzie was born in Atlanta, Georgia, on November 28, 1945,
4 attended the Georgia Military Academy and Hapeville High School, and went on to receive
5 from the University of Georgia a Bachelor of Business Administration in 1966 and a J.D. in
6 1969; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. McKenzie came to work for the General Assembly's Office of Legislative
8 Counsel in 1970 and ever since that time has continued to impress the members of the
9 legislature with his legal knowledge, wisdom, professionalism, untiring dedication to duty,
10 and unfailing courtesy and friendship; and

11 WHEREAS, in addition to displaying excellence in preparing legislation and providing legal
12 counsel for the membership of the General Assembly, he has also served as the lead attorney
13 for the Georgia Code Revision Commission since its creation, in which capacity he played
14 a large role in the highly successful and gargantuan task of preparing the first official
15 recodification of Georgia law since 1933; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. McKenzie has announced that he will retire from public service prior to the
17 2003 session of the General Assembly; and

18 WHEREAS, no one in Georgia history has ever attained a greater knowledge of Georgia's
19 statutory and legislative law or done more for its development and betterment.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the membership of this
21 body does hereby express to Terry A. McKenzie its abiding and sincere appreciation for his
22 important and excellent work for the Georgia General Assembly and the State of Georgia.
