

House Bill 1832 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Ashburn,"
2 approved April 13, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4075), so as to provide for the terms of office of
3 the mayor and councilpersons; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Ashburn," approved April 13,
7 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4075), is amended by striking Section 5.11 and inserting in lieu thereof
8 the following:

9 style="text-align:center">"SECTION 5.11.

10 style="text-align:center">Regular elections; time for holding.

11 Beginning in 2002 and every four years thereafter on the Tuesday following the first Monday
12 in November, there shall be an election for the office of mayor and two positions on the city
13 council. In 2003 on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November, there shall be an
14 election for three positions on the city council to serve for terms of one year. In 2004 and
15 every four years thereafter on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November, there
16 shall be an election for three positions on the city council to serve for terms of four years.
17 The terms of office shall begin at the organizational meeting as provided for in Section 2.18
18 of this charter."

19 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

20 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 5.13 and inserting in lieu thereof the
21 following:

1 "The person receiving a plurality of the votes for the office of mayor shall be elected. The
2 persons receiving the highest number of votes cast for city council positions shall be
3 elected."

4 **SECTION 3.**

5 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
