## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 43-34-103 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 application and number of physician's assistants, so as to change the number of physician's
- 3 assistants who may be licensed to a physician; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 43-34-103 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to application
- 8 and number of physician's assistants, is amended by striking subsection (b) thereof and
- 9 inserting in its place the following:
- 10 ''(b)(1) No physician shall have more than two four physician's assistants licensed to him
- or her at any one time; provided, however, that no physician may supervise more than
- two physician's assistants at any one time except as provided in paragraph (2) of this
- 13 <u>subsection</u>.
- 14 (2) However, a A physician may supervise more than two physician's assistants while
- on call for a solo practitioner or as a member of a group practice setting, for example,
- including but not limited to clinics, hospitals, and other institutions. The physician taking
- call must be approved to supervise the physician's assistant of the physician for whom
- he or she is taking call."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
