

ADOPTED

1 Senator Stephens of the 51st offered the following amendment:

2 Amend SB 291 by inserting on line 8 of page 1, immediately following the word and symbol
3 "Act;" the following:

4 "to provide for the adoption by local boards of education of policies regarding unruly
5 behavior of students on school buses; to provide for a monetary reward to certain students
6 reporting the presence of an explosive device or a weapon on real property used for public
7 elementary or secondary education;"

8 By inserting between lines 21 and 22 of page 4 the following:

9 **"SECTION 5.**

10 Said chapter is further amended in Subpart 1A of Part 2 of Article 16, relating to an improved
11 student learning environment and discipline, by adding two new Code sections to be
12 designated 20-2-735.1 and 20-2-735.2 to read as follows:

13 '20-2-735.1.

14 Each local board of education shall adopt policies that prohibit unruly behavior on school
15 buses and shall require such prohibition to be included in student codes of conduct. Local
16 board policies shall require that, upon finding that a student has engaged in unruly behavior
17 on a school bus for the second time in a school year, such student shall be suspended from
18 riding the bus for the remainder of that school year.

19 20-2-735.2.

20 Each local school system shall provide for a \$500.00 reward to the first student who reports
21 the presence of an explosive device or a weapon, as defined in Code Section 16-11-127.1,
22 on real property used for public elementary or secondary education."

23 By renumbering Section 5 as Section 6.
