1 Senators Burton of the 5<sup>th</sup> and Williams of the 6<sup>th</sup> offered the following amendment:

2 Amend House Bill 479 by inserting "to require photographic identification of voters at the  
3 polling places prior to voting and to eliminate the ability to submit an affidavit in lieu of  
4 presenting a valid form of identification;" following "circumstances;" on line 2 of page 3 and  
5 by inserting between lines 10 and 11 of page 32 the following:

6 **"SECTION 42A.**

7 Said chapter is further amended by striking Code Section 21-2-417, relating to identification  
8 of voters at the polls, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 '21-2-417.

10 (a) Each elector shall present proper identification to a poll worker at or prior to  
11 completion of a voter's certificate at any polling place and prior to such person's admission  
12 to the enclosed space at such polling place. Proper identification shall consist of any one  
13 of the following:

14 (1) A valid Georgia driver's license;

15 (2) A valid identification card containing a photograph of the elector and issued by a  
16 branch, department, agency, or entity of the State of Georgia, any other state, or the  
17 United States authorized by law to issue personal identification;

18 (3) A valid United States passport;

19 (4) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and  
20 issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government, this  
21 state, or any county, municipality, board, authority, or other entity of this state;

22 (5) A valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the elector and  
23 issued by any employer of the elector in the ordinary course of such employer's business;

24 (6) A valid student identification card containing a photograph of the elector from any  
25 public or private college, university, or postgraduate technical or professional school  
26 located within the State of Georgia; or

27 ~~(7) A valid Georgia hunting or fishing license;~~

28 ~~(8) A valid Georgia license to carry a pistol or revolver;~~

29 ~~(9) A valid pilot's license issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other  
30 authorized agency of the United States;~~

31 ~~(10)~~ (7) A valid United States military identification card containing a photograph of the  
32 elector;

33 ~~(11) A certified copy of the elector's birth certificate;~~

1       ~~(12) A valid social security card;~~  
2       ~~(13) Certified naturalization documentation; or~~  
3       ~~(14) A certified copy of court records showing adoption, name, or sex change.~~  
4       ~~(b) If an elector is unable to produce any of the items of identification listed in subsection~~  
5       ~~(a) of this Code section, he or she shall sign a statement under oath in a form approved by~~  
6       ~~the Secretary of State, separate and distinct from the elector's voter certificate, swearing or~~  
7       ~~affirming that he or she is the person identified on the elector's voter certificate. Such person~~  
8       ~~shall be allowed to vote without undue delay. Falsely swearing or affirming such statement~~  
9       ~~under oath shall be punishable as a felony, and the penalty shall be distinctly set forth on the~~  
10       ~~face of the statement."~~.
