1 Senators Seabaugh of the 28th, Mullis of the 53rd, Beatty of the 47th, and Paul of the 40th
2 offered the following amendment:

3 Amend the Senate Public Safety Committee substitute to HB 385 by striking line 1 of page
4 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 "To amend Title 40".

6 By inserting at the beginning of line 3 on page 1 the following:

7 "provide for destruction of certain fingerprint records; to repeal the authorization for
8 requiring fingerprinting and similar identification of applicants for drivers' licenses; to
9 repeal the authorization for requiring fingerprinting and similar identification of applicants
10 for identification cards; to repeal the authorization for requiring fingerprinting and similar
11 identification of applicants for identification cards for persons with disabilities; to".

12 By inserting after Section 1-0 the following:

13 **"SECTION 1-0A.**

14 Said title is further amended in Code Section 40-5-2, relating to keeping of records of
15 applications for licenses and information on licensees, by striking subsection (k) and
16 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

17 '(k)(1) The department, pursuant to rules and regulations promulgated by the
18 commissioner, may periodically review all records maintained pursuant to this Code
19 section and shall correct those records which contain known improper, false, fraudulent,
20 or invalid information.

21 (2) Not later than 90 days after the effective date of this paragraph, the department shall
22 destroy all records of fingerprints obtained on and after April 15, 1996, and prior to the
23 effective date of this paragraph from applicants for drivers' licenses, identification cards,
24 and identification cards for persons with disabilities issued by the department.'

25 **SECTION 1-0B.**

26 Said title is further amended by striking Code Section 40-5-28, relating to issuance of
27 licenses and fingerprinting of applicants, and inserting in its place the following:

28 '40-5-28.

1 The department shall, upon payment of the required fee, issue to every applicant qualifying
 2 therefor a driver's license indicating the type or general class of vehicles the licensee may
 3 drive, which license shall be upon a form prescribed by the department and which shall
 4 bear thereon a distinguishing number assigned to the licensee, a color photograph of the
 5 licensee, the licensee's full name, either a facsimile of the signature of the licensee or a
 6 space upon which the licensee shall write his or her usual signature with a pen and ink
 7 immediately upon receipt of the license, and such other information or identification as is
 8 required by the department. No license shall be valid until it has been so signed by the
 9 licensee. ~~Specifically but without limitation, the department may require applicants to~~
 10 ~~submit fingerprints by means of an inkless fingerprint scanning device upon application."~~

11 By inserting after Section 1-3 the following:

12 **"SECTION 1-3A.**

13 Said title is further amended by striking paragraph (11) of subsection (a) of Code Section
 14 40-5-100, relating to department authorized issuance and contents of identification cards, and
 15 inserting in its place the following:

16 '(11) ~~Fingerprint of person identified~~ Reserved; and'.

17 **SECTION 1-3B.**

18 Said title is further amended by striking paragraph (12) of subsection (a) of Code Section
 19 40-5-171, relating to issuance and contents of identification cards for persons with
 20 disabilities, and inserting in its place the following:

21 '(12) ~~Fingerprint of person identified~~ Reserved; and'.
