

WITHDRAWN

1 Senators Beatty of the 47th, Harp of the 16th, Seabaugh of the 28th, Johnson of the 1st and
2 Williams of the 6th offered the following amendment:

3 Amend the committee substitute to SB 204 by striking the double quotation mark on line 9
4 of page 7 and by inserting between lines 9 and 10 of page 7 the following:

5 "(k) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 to play any amusement game
6 or device which consists of: any slot machine or any video game machine or device
7 operated by a slot in which is deposited a coin or thing of value for the play of poker,
8 blackjack, keno, lotto, bingo, or craps; any machine or device pertaining to games of
9 chance of whatever name or kind, including those machines, boards, or other devices that
10 display different pictures, words, or symbols at different plays or different numbers; or any
11 matchup or lineup game machine or device which requires the player to use skill stops to
12 complete the game. It shall be unlawful for any person owning or possessing any such
13 game or device, or any person employed by or acting on behalf of any such person, to
14 allow a person under the age of 18 to play such game or device. Any machine referred to
15 in this subsection shall have a prominent notice displayed thereon as follows: 'IT IS A
16 CRIME TO PLAY THIS MACHINE IF YOU ARE UNDER 18 OR TO ALLOW A
17 PERSON UNDER 18 TO PLAY THIS MACHINE.' Any person who violates this
18 subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."
