

ADOPTED

1 Senators Beatty of the 47th, Williams of the 6th, Stephens of the 51st, Mullis of the 53rd,
2 Perdue of the 18th and Seabaugh of the 28th offered the following amendment:

3 Amend the House substitute to SB 204 by adding after the semicolon on line 6 of page 1 the
4 following:

5 "to prohibit the giving or receiving of any thing of value for playing certain devices or
6 games;"

7 By striking all matter on lines 7 through 14 of page 5 and inserting in lieu thereof the
8 following:

9 "(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection, it shall be
10 unlawful for any person to give or receive anything of value other than one or more free
11 replays for playing any of the following devices or games:

12 (A) Any slot machine or any video game or device operated by a slot in which is
13 deposited a coin or thing of value for the play of poker, blackjack, or keno or any
14 simulation or variation thereof; or

15 (B) Any matchup or lineup game machine or device which requires the player to use
16 skill stops to complete the game.

17 Any person who violates this paragraph shall be guilty of commercial gambling and
18 punished as provided in Code Section 16-12-22."

19 By inserting a double quotation mark at the end of line 23 of page 7 and striking all matter
20 on lines 24 through 34 of page 7.
