- 1 To amend Code Section 17-3-2.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 statute of limitations on prosecution of certain offenses involving a victim under 16 years of
- 3 age, so as to extend the time from which the applicable period within which a prosecution
- 4 must be commenced begins to run; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

- 7 Code Section 17-3-2.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the statute of
- 8 limitations on prosecution of certain offenses involving a victim under 16 years of age, is
- 9 amended by striking subsection (a) of said Code section and inserting in its place the
- 10 following:
- 11 "(a) If the victim of a violation of:
- 12 (1) Code Section 16-5-70, relating to cruelty to children;
- 13 (2) Code Section 16-6-1, relating to rape;
- 14 (3) Code Section 16-6-2, relating to sodomy and aggravated sodomy;
- 15 (4) Code Section 16-6-3, relating to statutory rape;
- 16 (5) Code Section 16-6-4, relating to child molestation and aggravated child molestation;
- 17 (6) Code Section 16-6-5, relating to enticing a child for indecent purposes; or
- 18 (7) Code Section 16-6-22, relating to incest,
- is under 16 years of age on the date of the violation, the applicable period within which a
- prosecution must be commenced under Code Section 17-3-1 or other applicable statute
- shall not begin to run until the victim has reached the age of 16 30 or the violation is
- reported to a law enforcement agency, prosecuting attorney, or other governmental agency,
- 23 whichever occurs earlier. Such law enforcement agency or other governmental agency shall
- promptly report such allegation to the appropriate prosecuting attorney."
