

Senate Bill 116

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

To amend Code Section 43-10-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to applications for certificates of registration for cosmetologists, so as to exempt certain persons from the education requirements of this Code section; to provide for an automatic repealer; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.**

Code Section 43-10-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to applications for certificates of registration for cosmetologists, is amended by inserting at the end thereof a new subsection (i) to read as follows:

"(i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the education requirements of this Code section shall not be applicable to any person who was enrolled in a school of cosmetology, school of esthetics, or any program under the jurisdiction of the Department of Technical and Adult Education or the State Board of Education on or before July 1, 2000."

**SECTION 2.**

This Act shall be automatically repealed on July 1, 2005.

**SECTION 3.**

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

**SECTION 4.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
