

House Bill 414

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide that the judge of the Juvenile Court of Floyd County shall be appointed in the
2 manner specified by general law; to provide for the continuation in office and expiration of
3 term of the current judge; to provide for vacancies; to provide for the specific repeal of an
4 Act providing for the election of the judge of the Juvenile Court of Floyd County, approved
5 April 12, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 4190), as amended; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Effective January 1, 2003, the judge of the Juvenile Court of Floyd County shall be
10 appointed in the manner specified by general law. There shall be no election in 2002 or
11 thereafter for the office of judge of the Juvenile Court of Floyd County.

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 The judge of the Juvenile Court of Floyd County who is serving as such on January 1, 2001,
14 and any person selected to fill a vacancy in such office shall continue to serve as such judge
15 for a term of office which shall expire December 31, 2002.

16 **SECTION 3.**

17 An Act providing for the election of the judge of the Juvenile Court of Floyd County,
18 approved April 12, 1982 (Ga. L. 1982, p. 4190), as amended, is repealed in its entirety.

19 **SECTION 4.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
