A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to obstruction of public administration and related offenses, so as to make it unlawful
- 3 to obstruct or hinder a person from making an emergency telephone call; to provide an
- 4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 10 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 obstruction of public administration and related offenses, is amended by striking in its
- 9 entirety Code Section 16-10-24.3, relating to the offense of obstructing or hindering persons
- 10 making emergency telephone calls, and inserting in lieu thereof a new Code Section
- 11 16-10-24.3 to read as follows:
- 12 "16-10-24.3.

- Any person who verbally or physically obstructs, prevents, or hinders another person with
- 14 intent to cause or allow physical harm or injury to another person from making or
- 15 completing a 911 telephone call or a call to any law enforcement agency to request police
- protection or to report the commission of a crime is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall,
- upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or imprisonment
- not to exceed 12 months, or both."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
- 21 it is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
