

Senate Bill 144

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend an Act creating the Recorder's Court of Gwinnett County, approved March 27, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3125), as amended, so as to change provisions relating to the salary of the judges of such court; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act creating the Recorder's Court of Gwinnett County, approved March 27, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3125), as amended, is amended by striking in its entirety Section 7 and inserting in its place a new Section 7 to read as follows:

"SECTION 7.

Judges' compensation.

The salary of the judges of the recorder's court shall be equal to 80 percent of the salary of a judge of superior court of the Gwinnett Judicial Circuit including any supplement, which salary shall be paid by the governing authority of Gwinnett County. In addition, each of the judges shall continue to receive all ordinary and routine benefits offered to employees of the county. These benefits shall include any longevity or bonus pay, and all other health, dental, retirement, or other benefits provided to county employees. The governing authority shall also have the right to provide for an additional county supplement for said judges if it determines it is appropriate and necessary."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective January 1, 2002.
