A RESOLUTION

1 Welcoming citizens and public officials from Macon and Bibb County, observing February
2 28, 2001, as Macon Day in Atlanta-Taste of Macon, recognizing the 2001 Cherry Blossom
3 Festival; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, public officials and citizens from Macon, Georgia, and Bibb County annually
5 come to the General Assembly to meet with the area's legislative delegation. A healthy
6 democracy demands an active interchange of ideas between citizens and their elected
7 representatives; and

18 afforded by The Taste of Macon; and

21 beautiful sight that signals the arrival of spring in the State of Georgia; and
