5 educator in the Douglas County School System and is a teacher at Chapel Hill High School;

8 Georgia College and has been a teacher for seven years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, she is a member of the Georgia Association of Educators, the Georgia Athletic
10 Coaches Association, the American Vocational Association, the Georgia Marketing
11 Educators Association, and the Marketing Educators Association, and is deeply involved in
12 her community through her church and her charitable activities; and
- 13 WHEREAS, she has been recognized often over her career in education for her abilities,
14 enthusiasm, and dedication to her profession; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she believes that her role as a teacher is to act as an instrument of inspiration
16 and enthusiasm to her pupils and to create a positive learning environment for her students
17 and to be a mentor to them; and
- 18 WHEREAS, in recognition of her outstanding dedication to academic achievement and the
19 teaching profession, she was selected as the 2001 Douglas County Teacher of the Year; and
- 20 WHEREAS, she is a shining example of the important impact that the efforts of individual
21 classroom teachers are making on the quality of education received by the children of this

1 state and it is abundantly fitting and proper that her superlative accomplishments be
2 recognized appropriately.

4 the members of this body heartily and gratefully commend Mrs. Mandy S. Johnson for her
