10 Commission and served as chair of the commission during county-wide rezoning and the

- 14 WHEREAS, she has long been known as a tireless community volunteer, having served as
15 a volunteer for the Mothers March, president of the Fowler Drive Elementary School PTA,
16 president of the Athens Jaycettes, co-chair of the Athens Academy Country Fair, and a
17 volunteer for various community projects sponsored by the Athens Women's Club; and
