5 educator in the Carroll County School System and is a teacher at Sharp Creek Elementary
6 School; and

8 Elementary, ever willing to go the extra mile in helping her fellow faculty and staff members
9 and working to help the children of Sharp Creek Elementary; and

11 master's degree in curriculum and instruction from Tusculum College and has been a teacher

20 selected as the 2002 Carroll County Teacher of the Year; and

2 classroom teachers are making on the quality of education received by the children of this
3 state and it is abundantly fitting and proper that her superlative accomplishments be
4 recognized appropriately.
