A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Bonaire Middle School Eighth Grade Jazz Band; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Bonaire Middle School Eighth Grade Jazz Band is pretty well known in
4 Houston County, Georgia, and it has brought considerable fame and honor to the school, the
5 parents, and the community; and

6 WHEREAS, these young musicians have demonstrated tremendous talent and discipline as
7 they explore the task of learning to play their instruments technically while mastering the art
8 of performing together as a concert band; and

9 WHEREAS, the Jazz Band was conceived by Band Director Bruce Fisher just three years
10 ago and school interest has rapidly grown to create this year's 21 member band that has a full
11 complement of saxophones, trombones, trumpets, keyboards, and drums; and

12 WHEREAS, these young men and women have acquired an eagerness toward music
13 education and developed a great love for the sheer art of playing, and the connection these
14 young players have made with the wonderful world of music shapes their identity and focus
15 and provides them experiences they will treasure for the rest of their lives.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize and commend the Bonaire Middle School Jazz Band and welcome the players and
18 their band director and assistant as they hold their premier performance in the grand rotunda
19 of our state capitol at the noon hour on February 14, 2001.
